- Please staple all attachments together with each application. Do not include binders or report covers. Please submit two complete sets of each application.
- Most scholarship applications are due to the Grand Island Community Foundation office located at 410 West 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Suite 2, Grand Island, NE 68801, on or before March 1. When March 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday, applications will be due the Monday immediately following the 1<sup>st</sup>.
